NASA SEWP VI Overview

The NASA SEWP (Solutions for Enterprise-Wide Procurement), pronounced "soup", provides the latest Information Technology, Communication, and Audio-Visual (ITC/AV) solutions and services for all Federal Agencies and their approved contractors. Created in 1993, SEWP I was the first Government-Wide acquisition Contract (GWAC) in the federal acquisition space. Originally, the contract vehicle provided only technology products for NASA and all other agencies. SEWP has continually evolved over the past 30 years, expanding its scope to meet the requests of its customers. The SEWP vehicle represents acquisition innovation within the Federal Government. The program is self-funded through usage fees (0.34%) and provides all Federal agencies with acquisition support - more than 50,000 orders a year.

FAIR OPPORTUNITY

FAR 16.505(b) (1) provides that each contractor shall be given fair opportunity to be considered for each order exceeding the micro-purchase threshold and issued under multiple award contracts. The FAR states that the method to obtain fair opportunity is at the discretion of the Contracting Officer (CO) and that the CO must document the rationale for placement and price of each order.

Using the SEWP online Quote Request Tool is the recommended method to assist in this activity and to augment the required decision documentation. The SEWP Quote Request Tool (QRT) will automatically include the Contract Holders within a selected group or based on a suggested source.

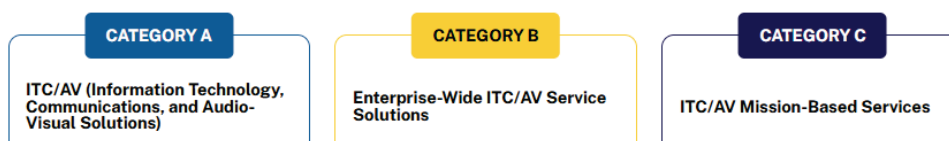

How to Obtain a Quote

There are three ways to request a quote from TES Consultants. All three reach the same team.

Request Methods

Method	How It Works
SEWP Quote Request Tool (QRT)	Recommended. Submit the RFQ through the SEWP website (www.sewp.nasa.gov), selecting TES Consultants directly or including TES Consultants in the applicable Category C group. TES receives the request through the Contract Holder Only Page (CHOP) and responds within the RFQ deadline.
Email	Send the requirement to compliance@tesconsultants.com ; Acknowledged within one business day.
Direct contact	Call or email the SEWP VI Program Manager or Deputy Program Manager listed above.

What to Include in a Category C Request

Providing the following up front shortens turnaround and reduces clarification cycles:

- Agency, ordering office, and program the work supports
- Statement of Work, Performance Work Statement, or Statement of Objectives
- Period of performance, including base and option periods
- Anticipated contract type (FFP, T&M, Labor-Hour, or a hybrid)
- Labor categories, estimated hours or FTEs, and required skill levels

- Place(s) of performance and on-site / remote / hybrid expectations
- Security requirements — clearance levels, suitability, badging, and facility access
- Deliverables, service levels, and any required certifications or standards
- Travel and other direct cost assumptions
- Quote due date, evaluation approach, and CO/COR points of contact

Response Standards

Action	TES Standard
Acknowledge receipt of an RFQ	Within 1 business day
Clarification questions submitted to the customer	Within 3 business days of receipt
Quote delivered — routine services requirement	Within 5 business days
Quote delivered — complex or multi-year requirement	Within 10 business days, or by the RFQ deadline
Quote validity period	30 calendar days from issue; <i>Every TES Consultants quote states its validity period on its face, as required by the SEWP Contract Holder User Manual.</i>
Quote format	Delivered through the QRT with a CLIN verification file whose line items and total match the quote exactly
